Session: Perioperative Evaluations – Nightmare Decisions

Dr. Lewis, a general internist, is Adjunct Professor of Medicine at the University of Tennessee Health Science Center. He has served as Associate Chief of Staff for Education at VAMC Memphis since 2007. He received his medical degree from Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine in 1976. He was resident and chief resident in internal medicine at Baptist Memorial Hospital Memphis from 1976-1980. He served as Program Director in Internal Medicine at Baptist Memorial Hospital and later served as the Program Director of Internal Medicine at the University of Tennessee until 2007. He is a Master in the American College of Physicians, and the annual University of Tennessee internal medicine teaching award is named in his honor. Clinically he serves as a hospitalist for at least two to three months each year, conducts resident morning reports three times each week, and runs a preoperative clinic at the VA.
